



MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN

UW Advanced Materials Industrial Consortium

desires to provide funds for the UW Advanced Materials Industrial Consortium (UWAMIC).

- 1) The UWAMIC will be under the administration of the MRSEC and NSEC of the College of Engineering at the University of Wisconsin-Madison (UW), and its activities will be conducted under the supervision of UWAMIC Co-Directors, Professors Juan J. de Pablo and Paul F. Nealey, Dr. Jon McCarthy or their successor(s).
- 2) In support of the UWAMIC, the Donor will contribute to the University of Wisconsin Foundation, the sum of _____, as the Membership fee for a one year membership in the UWAMIC, to be paid upon acceptance of the Agreement by the UWAMIC Director and Dean of the College of Engineering. Checks should be made payable to "University of Wisconsin Foundation" and sent to the Center Director, UWAMIC, University of Wisconsin-Madison, 1415 Engineering Drive, Madison, WI 53706.
- 3) The Donor declares their intent to provide annual membership fees to support the UWAMIC for at least ONE year. This declaration of intent does not obligate the Donor to make such payments, but the Donor will attempt, in good faith, to provide at least one year's notice of any intent to withdraw or reduce its level of support.
- 4) The University of Wisconsin Foundation will keep these funds in a segregated account and will transfer them to the UWAMIC at the University of Wisconsin for the support of activities on the instruction of either the UWAMIC Director or his/her authorized representative. These funds will be used to support the various activities of the UWAMIC as indicated below, including, but not limited to: purchase of necessary supplies and equipment; defraying of travel and other necessary expenses; expenses for conducting conferences, workshops and seminars; costs for development

and mailing of publications; support for staff, graduate research assistants and/or faculty; and to employ other competent workers to carry on the UWAMIC activities.

- 5) The University will furnish laboratory and office facilities and such usual equipment as is required for UWAMIC activities insofar as the facilities of the University will permit.
- 6) Upon termination of this agreement, any equipment, materials or supplies in stock will remain the property of the University of Wisconsin-Madison
- 7) The UWAMIC will carry out the following activities:
 - a. Organize technical workshops for Donors to transfer knowledge relating to the aspects of advanced materials and nanoscale technology that are of interest to UWAMIC members.
 - b. Provide donors a website and telephone consultation that serves as an informational resource and repository of authoritative information on advanced materials and nanotechnology.
- 8) The Donor understands that the University of Wisconsin, in accepting membership funds for the purpose and activities herein stated, intends that they shall be used for the promotion of scientific knowledge of advanced materials and its related fields and that the results of such research shall be disseminated by the University, through publication or otherwise, in any manner that it may deem desirable, keeping in mind that the public interest or welfare shall be dominant. However, no information that is confidential or proprietary to a Donor under this agreement, and that was clearly identified as such (either in written or oral format) at the time it was received by UWAMIC staff, will be included in any of the UWAMIC reports or public seminars or conferences.

This memorandum will be in effect for one year from date final signature and is declared effective upon the signatures of the Director of the UWAMIC and the Dean of the College of Engineering, University of Wisconsin-Madison and the proper officials for _____ (name of donor).
